Scholarship value

Students will be awarded a scholarship of 25% off the tuition fee for each year of study for the minimum standard duration of the undergraduate or postgraduate degree.

Commencing an undergraduate qualification

- Minimum ATAR score of 80 (VCE, HSC, ACT, SACE, TCE, WACE), or International Baccalaureate (IB) score of 28.

Commencing a postgraduate qualification

- Successful completion of a recognised higher education program within Australia.

University of Adelaide Higher Education Scholarships

This scholarship is awarded to international students who demonstrate their loyalty to Australian education by completing a recognised degree or program at an Australian Higher Education (AQF) institution. International students undertaking Australian year 12 curriculum's either in Australia or overseas who have achieved academic merit in their studies are eligible for the Higher Education scholarship to be applied.
