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
From the Principal


Year 12 Parents

Parents of Year 12 students – thank you for helping your child to plan for the next stage of their learning at tertiary institutions. Please know that so far, we have:

- Discussed future pathways with the Year 12's as a group
- Had a session with SATAC about applying to university as an International student.
- Explained how ATARs are achieved.
- Been to Flinders University to attend the International School Student Day with Adelaide University, the University of South Australia and TAFE.
- Holding individual discussions with students about their university application. This is still in progress for a few Year 12s.

Now, students need to submit their university applications fully online before 30 September to avoid a late penalty fee on application. Speak with Ms Sally Xu or myself if you have any further questions.

Examinations

An important part of the learning experience at Adelaide International School, is the way to prepare for and succeed at the examination assessment type. Due to the students coming from a range of learning experiences, we know the importance of teaching students how to approach learning for and completing examinations in South Australia.

The learning behaviours for examination preparation are different to how a student will complete daily homework or an inquiry task. Students must learn how to plan, how to use their time within the examination and how to interpret a question. Students need to make examination study notes and commit these to memory. Students also need to work through past SACE examination papers available through our staff and examination style questions under timed conditions. Our Year 12 teachers have started asking students to complete previous year's examinations for study times and during the weekends. This rigorous, important task is very important for the students, especially for those who are not confident with the examination style assessment type. Do make time to talk to your child about this activity.
