- From 2024, Full Year 10 ACARA course with IGCSE electives for students seeking a Cambridge International pathway to AS and A-level and a global reach to University Entrance.
- Full Year 11 and Year 12 SACE completion, (accommodating university and vocational pathways) for domestic and international students.
 - Study Tours, offering come-and-try opportunities to international students.


Integrity – Adelaide International students, know, practice and seek to be honest and honourable
