CRITERIA

The following criteria will be used to determine if an applicant will be awarded a scholarship:

- Financial need EVIDENCE: letter from parents that outlines the financial need and includes information about the occupation of parents and the number of siblings.
- Academic performance that is of at least average to high competence. Passing grades in English will be essential.
 EVIDENCE: the two most recent school reports.
- Contribution to the school or wider community.
 EVIDENCE: Certificates (if appropriate)
 Letter of commendation from a teacher or school principal or community member.

EXPECTATIONS

It is an expectation that each scholarship holder will:

- 1. Demonstrate ongoing commitment to effective study.
- 2. Obtain average or better-than-average results.
- 3. Demonstrate the values of Adelaide International School.
- 4. Have an attendance rate of more than 90% unless extenuating circumstances prevent this.
- 5. Meet the expectations outlined in the student Code of Conduct.
- 6. Be a positive role model within AIS showing leadership when appropriate.
- 7. Assist new students to settle in to the school.
- 8. Assist AIS to promote the scholarship program of AIS.

It is an expectation that parents will:

- 1. Assist their son/daughter to meet the obligations of the scholarship.
- 2. Cooperate with AIS if a strategy is put in place to ensure that student obligations are met.

APPLICATION PROCESS

To be considered for a scholarship, please complete the AIS Scholarship Application Form and ensure the following documents are supplied as part of your application process:

- Copy of passport
- Reference letter from the school Principal or a teacher that outlines why the student would be a suitable candidate for a scholarship and summaries the contribution made to the community
- Letter from parents that outlines the financial need
- Copies of the last two school reports
- Certificates awarded for success in an area at school of in the community
- A statement of 300 words outlining why you would like to receive the scholarship. This will include information about your anticipated future study or career.
