BIG DAY OUT VICTOR HARBOUR

DAY TRIP TO KANGAROO ISLAND



Kangaroo Island is a nature lovers paradise, with native wildlife, and dramatic sightseeing. Kangaroo Island lies 13 kms off the coast of South Australia is one of the best places in Australia to see wild animals like koala, kangaroos, sealion and seals.

DAY TRIP TO CLELAND, MOUNT LOFTY BOTANICAL GARDENS, AND MELBA'S CHOCOLATE FACTORY

Travel by private transport to Cleland Wildlife Park to meet and interact with some of Australia's most beloved native animals on this day trip from Adelaide to Cleland Wildlife Park in the Adelaide Hills. Learn about koalas, feed wallabies and kangaroos and be amused by wombats and emus, and observe dingos, tasmanian devils and more. Then, visit the Mt. Lofty Summit and Botanic Gardens for panoramic views and take in a visit to Melba's Chocolate Factory.



DAY TRIP TO HAHNDORF




