Criteria of Scholarship

- Applicants will have to undertake an interview with the Principal or a delegated AIS staff member.
- The scholarship will be offered for the duration of the course but will be reviewed annually to ensure student's expectations have been met. In the event the student does not meet the expectation, the Principal can provide a written reason as to why the scholarship is withdrawn.
- Scholarships are based on full course tuition fees, not on any discounted fees.
- Scholarships are awarded based on individual merit and not all applicants will receive scholarships.
- Scholarships are awarded to applicants who best meet the application criteria.
- In general, a scholarship will not exceed 50% of course fees. A scholarship in excess of 50% will only be granted in exceptional circumstances.
- Scholarships do not apply to any fees other than tuition fees. Uniforms, Homestay fees, Material fees, etc. are not subject to a scholarship discount.
- The terms and conditions applicable to payment of fees will apply to scholarship holders.
- Applicants can support their application with evidence from any of the other categories but can apply only for one category.
